

NOTTAWA TOWNSHIP MINUTES

JUNE , 2018

Meeting opened at 7 with the pledge of allegiance. All board members present.

Fox made motion to accept minutes from last meeting, Marchiando 2nd .

Local Gov: Dave Livermore reported on roads being fixed this year.

Public Comment: Larry King running for Prosecutor and Sara Spencer running for probate judge, introduced themselves to the board.

Comments were made on the sewer system and windmills.

Treasurer's report: \$7802.52 in checking, savings is \$35,1358.21 and sewer has \$52,294.22. Bills were presented. Motion made by Green, 2nd by Fox for Schumacher to amend the budget. Approved

Fire Dept: Green reported that the township will have to go back to paying quarterly payments. Fire chief Livermore stated that the windmills will not hinder the fire dept. from doing their job. They will be going thru intensive training and will respond to a house fire near a turbine.

Old Business: Sewer update: Engineers are working on getting the special assessment districts. A special meeting will be held on June 18 with an open meeting on Aug. 6. Place and time to be determined.

2% grant came in. \$13,025 for the asphalt and cement work and \$12,500 for general distribution.

Striping for the new asphalt will be done on June 6.

New Business: Fox made motion for Local Community Stabilization to use electronic deposit. Schumacher 2nd. Approved
