Old Business: Our attorney, Matt, informed us on the ACO order. Motion by Fox, 2nd by Marchiando to give Kory the authority to sign the documents for settlement as long as they are consistent with the order. Approved. all ayes

Kory and Pete Lorenz have been working on the special assessments and deciding which is the best way to go for the sewer. Joe White from Wolverine will be letting Kory know before the next meeting.

Resolution 5/7/2018/1 which approves the ballot language for the August 7, 2018 election has been passed. This is for the voters to decide if they want an ordinance creating a planning commission. Motion was made by Fox, 2nd by Marchiando. All ayes.

Resolution 5/7/2018/2 has been passed. This allows the voters to decide if they want an increase in mills to pay for the planning commission purposes. Motions by Marchiando and Schumacher. All ayes Park is open.

Straus's will be doing the work on the entry to the hall within the month.

New Business: Township audit is May 24th. Schumacher will check out another auditor.

Motion made by Schumacher 2nd by Fox to have our website taking care of by outside person. Approved
