

NOTTAWA TOWNSHIP MINUTES

APR. 5, 2021

Zoom meeting opened at 7:00 with the pledge of allegiance. Trustee Pat Marchiando was absent.

Agenda approved.

Minutes of last meeting approved.

Local Government: none

Public Comment: none

Treasurer's report: Checking \$42,476.44, savings \$621,081.57, sewer \$194,618.22, Sewer construction \$1,263,841.29, cd's \$808,972.55. Treasurer's report and approval to pay bills and any bills that come in during the month approved.

Fire Report: AT&T paid the \$8,000 they were behind in tower rent and will be paying \$1,000 per month going forward.

Old Business:

Beal City/Coldwater Lake Sewer Project – work continues on the main line to Mt. Pleasant and work will begin soon on leads to houses/businesses in Beal City. We will likely need to hold a special meeting in April or May to discuss how permits/fees/inspections will be handled for homeowners/business owners. We may also need to hold a meeting for contractors who want to provide the hook ups for homes and businesses to explain what is required. A motion was made and approved by all to accept the agreement with Beal City Public School regarding the sewer system.

Spring 2% - we applied for Fire Department vehicle, BS&A software and computer for utility billing and paving of the parking lot at the township park.

2021/2022 Budget – budget was finalized in March; no action needed.

North Drive abandonment – discussed an easement for sewer project and approval of abandonment request.

New Business:

April Pay Estimates - Motions were made to accept pay requests and the administrative invoices and were approved by all members of the board.

Renewal of Property and Liability Insurance – discussed the need to add the sewer system to the policy; Burnham & Flower will send a new quote before the May meeting for approval.

Continue meetings by Zoom – a motion was made and approved by all to continue meetings via Zoom until further notice. The meeting ID is 7828713566.
