

NOTTAWA TOWNSHIP MINUTES

SPECIAL MEETING JULY 29, 2021

Meeting opened at 7 p.m. via Zoom. All board members present.

Discussed the need to amend sections 7.10 (B), 3.4(A) and 4.19 of the Sewer Ordinance. Township attorney Dave Stoker was present – he will work on the amendments and get them to us for consideration at next week’s meeting.

Discussed the need to adopt Technical Standards for the sewer system. Pete and Joe will email them to us for consideration before next week’s meeting.

Discussed the need to adopt administrative forms for joining the system and contractors. Pete and Joe will present at next week’s meeting.

Discussed the requirement that the township is responsible for inspecting each sewer connection at the right of way. Isabella county will inspect the lead up to the house. Attorney Stoker reminded us that fees should recover our actual costs.

Discussed the need for the Township to submit a request for an extension of time to EGLE and that it should probably come from Kory.

Contractor J. Rothenberger appeared and discussed the current state of the project. He did not get an extension of time request submitted for today’s meeting. Pete, Joe & Kory explained the liquidated damages possibilities. Joe suggested we approve the pay estimates on Monday, minus \$36,000 in liquidated damages and then hold another special meeting in August to consider a change order for an extension of time.
