

NOTTAWA TOWNSHIP MINUTES

JULY 6, 2020

Meeting opened at 7: 09 on zoom. All board members present

Agenda approved with additions.

Minutes of last meeting approved.

Local government: none

Public comment: none

Treasurer's report: Checking 15,704.45, savings \$475,253.10, Sewer \$35,794.87, cd's at \$8411091.28.

Motion made to pay bills as presented and 2nd. Approved

Fire Dept: 38 runs last month

Old Business: Joe White gave update on sewer. Pete and Joe are working with Rothenbergers on contracts 1 and 3 and with Crawford on contract 2 to try to get us closer to budget numbers. Possible savings on 1 by moving lines in Beal City, on 2 by eliminating the DPW building, chemical feed system and fencing for this year, also on 3 by changing the pipe size. This could reduce about \$152,000.

The township can borrow additional \$500,000 because of the low interest rate . Motion made and passed to authorize Kory to sign grant application by this Friday, July 10.

The asphalt at the park is getting scheduled. Kory is checking on the playground repair.

2% from the tribe came to \$5952 for general allocation.

New Business: Motion made to install CMS internet at the hall. Schumacher will handle this.

Election commission passed the election resolution July 6 2020 for the clerk to perform the election.

Hall rentals are still closed for this month.
